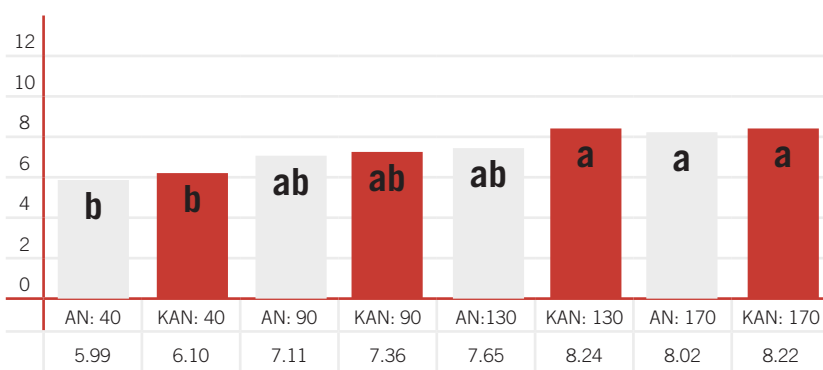
Treatments:

Nitrogen Rate (kg N/Ha)	Product Required (kg/Ha)	
	Ammonium Nitrate	Koch Advanced Nitrogen
40	116	87
90	261	196
130	377	283
170	493	370

Application split: 50% at Pre-Em. 50% at GS 12-13

Results:

N-types on Spring Barley ('Concerto'), SAG, Glenrothes, yield (t/Ha grain)



Means followed by same letter do not significantly differ (P= 0.05, Duncan's New MRT)

Conclusions:

- ▶ High nitrogen content of Koch Advanced Nitrogen® fertiliser means 33% less product is required to supply equal nitrogen compared to ammonium nitrate.
- ▶ Koch Advanced Nitrogen® fertiliser gave equal yields compared to ammonium nitrate at all nitrogen rates (P=0.05).
